Since last February, something incredible has been unfolding in the US House of Representatives. Legislation is needed to provide for proper medical treatment for babies who are born alive after a failed abortion attempt!

The House Republicans have called for immediate consideration of HR 962, the Born Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act-67Times!^

But, Democrat leaders in Congress refused to even consider it!

On April 2nd Minority Whip Steve Scalise (R-LA) and Rep. Ann Wagner (R-MO) used a Congressional procedure called a discharge petition that requires 218 signatures to bring the Born Alive bill up for a vote despite the objections of the Democrat leadership.

So far all House Republicans have signed the discharge petition and only 3 Democrats-17 more Democrat signatures are needed.

In August, Congress is on recess and our Representatives will be back in their home offices. Parishioners please be alert to what is happening and we encourage you to visit the home offices of the Democrat Representatives—telling them you expect to see their name on the discharge petition that will allow this bill to be brought to the House floor. Another important action you can do is to watch and share the videos found on the link at www.BornAlive.US.

I will be having lunch with Reps. Scalise and Wagner for lunch and hope to be able to tell them of your collaboration with us in this effort!

The Office for Youth and Young Adult Ministry serves to support the pastors, clergy, coordinators, and the parish communities of our Archdiocese as they work to minister to the young Church. Through a diverse program that includes leadership gatherings and trainings, youth and young adult events, and retreat opportunities, the office provides ongoing support and formation in the spirit of evangelization.

This past June and July the office hosted its third year of the series Love and Responsibility NJ: Young Adults Building Healthy Relationships with the collaboration of the Offices for Evangelization and Family Life.

In an era where there is much confusion about love and relationships, the series provides a life changing 4-week program based on St. John Paul II's *Love and Responsibility*. The themes are grounded in Dr. Edward Sri's *Men, Women and the Mystery of Love*. The series concludes with Holy Mass.

Each evening includes insightful talks, engaging witness, live praise and worship, and enthusiastic fellowship. This year, the series had a great lineup of Catholic speakers that included a Catholic therapist, theology professors, and a director of formation from one of our Catholic schools. Each evening focused on themes of Identity, Integrity, and Intimacy in marriage and in friendship. Overall, the annual series is an amazing event that gives young adults an opportunity to connect with their faith, the God who loves them, themselves, and each other. The 2019 series had a total attendance of over 420 young adults! They came, heard the message, and engaged in lively conversations with others who, like them, are looking to live purposeful and meaningful lives rooted in the truths of our faith.
