Dear Parishioners,

The other day I over heard a Mom and Dad scholding their child maybe six years old, saying your never "happy" you keep wanting more and more. That half minute conversation stayed in my head for the remainder of my day, I kept thinking about how that should have been handled so differently, in a kinder way in a normal tone of speach and not all that yelling from the both of them. I kept thinking that the ticking of the clock goes really fast—especially when you have children. Talking to children about toys, and what they want is a normal part of childhood, but if you are bringing your child up correctly there would be no scenes outside or inside your home about material things. Talk is so much more important than yelling and completely embarrassing each other.

In todays society our view of happiness depends so much on our circumstances, environment and greed. For a young woman true happiness might be to find the right man, to marry and have a family, only later to find herself thinking that true happiness would come if she could divorce her abusive husband. For teenagers, true happiness is getting their first car, but its not too long before they realize that they would be truly happy if they could have a certain car that was sleeker and I'm sure you can think of things that you would like to see changed in your life so that you can be truly happy. So we go about suitably arranging – and rearranging – our environment and circumstances – so that we will be happy. On this basis, people have assumed that, if they are unhappy, it is because of this wretched washing machine, this wretched heart, this wretched person I am living with... They believe that they will become happy by changing their lot in some way. It becomes a never-ending quest.

Happiness, we assume, must be fun and laughter and expressing our own personalities ("doing our own thing") – free from suffering, sorrow and hardship. It's no wonder that we can never say that we have reached our goal of true happiness. There is nothing wrong with the desire to be happy, there is everything wrong with the way we often go seeking it. You don't have to seek happiness, you already have it in you. You must learn the difference between wanting everything and just being happy with what God has given you. All the weddings costing thousands of dollars versus a City Hall one...well, its about what your doing, your marrying the person you love, starting your new life together, true happiness. Its not about a thousand dollar pair of shoes an outrageous banquet hall or a \$10,000. dress. Just to impress others so you can feel happy that everyone will talk about it. This just isn't the way....to feel true happiness. Think about it...think about what our Lord had, what Mary and Joseph had and they were happy. Say a prayer for what God has given you and your family. Be Happy. Your children are watching you, therefore acting like you.
