Our Pastor Fr. Minhyun Cho

Dear Brothers and Sisters of St. Michael's,

I've been a praying person for much of my life. Has it worked? Has it fixed me entirely? Apparently not, because I still have a long way to grow. You've no doubt prayed about some things, hoping for prayer to fix it, right? When we're sick, we pray for God to heal us. When we're poor, we pray for God to provide. All of those prayers are good prayers. God calls on us to trust him in such moments to move, to work and to act on our behalf. But still, praying doesn't "fix" all of the situations we encounter. In the **Book of Acts**, chapter four, we read the story of Peter and John being arrested for preaching about Jesus. Later, they're released after a strong lecture from the temple police about not continuing to spread the gospel. The church, in response, begins to pray. And here's the spoiler...the persecution issue actually gets worse. We sometimes place a burden on prayer that praying was never meant to handle. We treat prayer like a magic formula. If I say these words, the problem will instantly go away... What we essentially say to God is, "God, I've got this issue, and I'm asking you to fix it for me..." And when the problem doesn't resolve or go away quickly, we feel disappointed with God, discouraged about our circumstances, and disgusted with our own lack of faith. What if, instead of expecting praying to "fix" all of our negative circumstances, we trusted instead that God designed prayer to change the variables. Could it be that when I'm asking for God to fix my broken finances, his real desire is to change and grow my Prayer isn't a magic formula that instantly and easily fixes everything.

But prayer is definitely powerful to change the variables of any situation to which we apply its power ability to *manage* my finances? Perhaps, instead of miraculously fixing areas of conflict in my marriage, God's real aim is to change me and my spouse to be *more like Jesus* to each other. God often heals and provides in response to prayer in dramatic and miraculous ways. I've seen it. I believe in it.

But more often, he goes to work changing us and the people around us from the inside out—sometimes slowly and progressively—to be able to handle our challenges in different ways. Here's what prayer does do... Prayer changes all of the variables at work in any given situation, making possible either a miraculous and instantaneous deliverance or the slow, progressive change and growth necessary for overcoming adversity.

Handling life without prayer is like playing basketball with a flat ball. It just doesn't work. And we expect prayer to make us pro players who never miss a shot. But prayer really gives us an inflated ball—better equipment, better skills, better opportunities, more strength and speed and stamina Prayer isn't a magic formula that instantly and easily fixes everything.

But prayer is definitely powerful to change the variables of any situation to which we apply its power.—so the game becomes winnable. No a million dollars won't fall out of the sky, but maybe someone will send you a few dollars to help you in a bad financial time. The rest is up to you, let us face it everyone's prayers are heard, but God is asking you to put your part into it also. May you pray tonight and let God know just how much you appreciate all He does for you in your life.

Presidents Day Celebrated on Monday, February 18th, 2019



The third Monday of February is known as Presidents' Day in the United States. For nearly 100 years, America honored its first president, George Washington, on February 22. That was his birthday. But the date was not a national holiday until 1968. That year, the U.S. Congress passed a measure known as the Uniform Monday Holiday Act. The measure meant that some public holidays would always fall on a Monday. Today, the country honors its first president on the third Monday in February -- and not on Washington's real birthday. And the holiday is now commonly called Presidents' Day. Many say it also honors Abraham Lincoln's birthday. The nation's 16th president was born on February 12. The federal government, however, still recognizes the holiday as "Washington's Birthday." The Uniform Monday Holiday Act gives workers a three-day weekend. It also gives shops and marketers a chance to have special Presidents' Day sales.

Last year, Donald J. Trump made history when he took the oath of office as the 45th president of the United States. At 70 years old, he became the oldest elected president. Before Trump, Ronald Reagan was the oldest person to take office. He was 69 years old

when he became president in 1981. As the first billionaire president, Trump also replaced John F. Kennedy, the 35th president, as the richest man to serve as president.



Saint Michael's Memorial Guild Mass




Saint Michael's has a Memorial Guild Mass once a month on the first Saturday of the month at 9am held in the Church.
