



Overall, the annual series is an amazing event that gives young adults an opportunity to connect with their faith, the God who loves them, themselves, and each other.

The 2019 series had a total attendance of over 420 young adults! They came, heard the message, and engaged in lively conversations with others who, like them, are looking to live purposeful and meaningful lives rooted in the truths of our faith.


